⇒ **It's Official:** The 2008-09 basketball season, and a new era for the Red Flash, is here!!! Saint Francis travels to Lubbock, Texas, to take on Pat Knight's Texas Tech Red Raiders at 9 p.m. (EST) on Friday, Nov. 14. The game can be heard live on The EDGE 850 AM, and a live webstream will be available at [www.goRedFlash.com](http://www.goRedFlash.com) and [www.edge1400.com](http://www.edge1400.com). Joe Vesnesky is back for his 30th season calling Saint Francis basketball. He will be joined by former SFU Sports Information Director Pat Farabaugh in calling the action.

⇒ **Sizing Up The Red Raiders:** Texas Tech is a member of the Big 12 Conference. The Red Raiders finished 16-15 overall, and 7-9 in the Big 12, good for a tie for seventh place. Legendary head coach Bobby Knight coached the team until his son, Pat Knight, took over on Feb. 4, 2008. Pat Knight guided the team to a record of 4-7 down the stretch, including a 3-2 mark at United Spirit Arena. Texas Tech is entering its 84th season of men's basketball, and own an overall record of 1,231-931. The Red Raiders have made 13 NCAA Tournament appearances, and five NIT appearances.

⇒ **First Time For Everything:** The meeting between Saint Francis and Texas Tech signals the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

⇒ **Looking Ahead:** Following their season-opener at Texas Tech, the Red Flash will fly back to our nation's capitol to play American University at 7:30 p.m., on Monday, Nov. 17. SFU will return home to DeGol Arena to play a pair of in-state non-conference rivals - Duquesne (Nov. 20) and Bucknell (Nov. 22). The Red Flash will close out November with games at Lehigh (Nov. 24) and Youngstown State (Nov. 29). The Red Flash will play a total of six games in November.

⇒ **On The Tube:** Saint Francis will appear on regional television three times this season, including once at home in the comfort of DeGol Arena. The Red Flash will play host to St. Francis-NY on Saturday, Dec. 6, in a contest that will be televised live on MSG Network at Noon. The game will be televised to a tape delayed audience on FSN-Pittsburgh later that evening at 8 p.m.

Saint Francis versus St. Francis-NY will again be televised on the same two stations play in Brooklyn, New York, on Jan. 24. That contest will broadcast live on both MSG and FSN-Pittsburgh at 4 p.m.

Saint Francis' final televised game of the season will be on Feb. 7 at Wagner. The game will air live on MSG at 4 p.m. that day, while it will be shown on tape delay at 9 p.m. on Feb. 9, on FSN-Pittsburgh.

⇒ **Same Names, New Numbers:** Several Red Flash returnees will be sporting new numbers this season. Marquis Ford switched from No. 11 to No. 3; Kurt Hoffman changed from No. 45 to his old high school No. 54; Mislav Jukic changed his number from 35 to 13; Chris McFarland will wear No. 2 in lieu of No. 20; and Randy Spaid will now wear No. 21 instead of No. 40.

⇒ **Preseason Polls:** The Red Flash were selected by Northeast Conference coaches to finish 11th in the league in 2008-09. Saint Francis completed last season in a four-way tie for eighth place, just one game out of an NEC Tournament berth. The Red Flash are looking to make the NEC Tournament for the first time since 2004-05.

⇒ **Friday's Debut:** After five successful seasons as a head coach at Ly-

coming College, first-year Red Flash head coach Don Friday will make his Division I head coaching debut at Texas Tech. The contest will begin at 9 p.m. Eastern time. The game will be televised locally on the Texas Tech Television Network, and will be broadcast live on The EDGE 850 AM (Johnstown). Audio will also be available via the internet on [www.goRedFlash.com](http://www.goRedFlash.com) and [www.edge1400.com](http://www.edge1400.com).

⇒ **New Faces:** Junior Cedric Latimer and freshman Curtis Keys are new faces on the Red Flash roster this season. However, neither player will participate in 2008-09. Latimer, a transfer from Santa Clara, will sit out in compliance with NCAA transfer rules. Keys will take the year off to concentrate on academics.

⇒ **Joe Vesnesky Returns:** Long-time "Voice" of the Red Flash, Joe Vesnesky, returns for his 30th season in Loretto. Don Friday will be the sixth Saint Francis head coach in which he will cover, and he will cover SFU athletics under his sixth U.S President. Vesnesky's partner, Bernie Jubeck, will be the color commentator at all home games, and select road games.

⇒ **Tickets For Games at DeGol Arena:** Tickets for basketball games held at DeGol Arena can be purchased by calling 814-472-3286. General admission tickets are \$7.00 for adults, and \$4.00 for students/children (12 and under). Season ticket prices are as follows: Reserved chairback seats \$100; General Admission Adult \$65; General Admission Student/Children \$40.

⇒ **Alumni Night:** Saint Francis' annual Alumni Night has become a major attraction for former players, students and fans alike. The Red Flash will once again host an Alumni Night in 2008-09, with this year's event being held on Nov. 22, against Bucnell. It will mark a very busy day on campus as Saint Francis athletics will host a football game against Bryant at 1 p.m., a women's basketball game against Lehigh at 5 p.m., and then the men's basketball game against the Bison at 8 p.m.

⇒ **Schedule Changes:** In case you missed it, Saint Francis' contest vs. Duquesne has been changed from Dec. 19 to a 7 p.m. start on Thurs., Dec. 20, at DeGol Arena. Also, the Red Flash game versus CCSU on Jan. 17 has been moved from 7 p.m. to 4 p.m.

The event also included a Faculty vs. Greek Life basketball game, and introductions of both the Red Flash men's and women's basketball teams.

⇒ **Collections for Kids:** The Saint Francis Softball team is currently collecting items for the Children's Home of Pittsburgh and Mario Lemieux Family Center. The facility is located in Lawrenceville just down the street from the new Children's Hospital that is being built. The organization is non-profit depends upon donations to offer assistance to its families. The facility offers transitional care for infants and children, day care for medically fragile children, adoption services, and living space for families so that they may spend time with their children. To lend a helping

hand, we are including as many people across campus and beyond to collect as many items as possible. Every little bit helps! The Softball team will be collecting items and donations for this project on Saturday, November 22, 2008 at the football game, as well as the home men's and women's basketball games, at DeGol Arena.

⇒ **All-American Success:** Saint Francis has long been known for its reputation as a top university around the country, but it is not widely known that 33 current or former student-athletes have been honored for their success in and out of the classroom. SFU has had 33 all-time *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-Americans, as voted on by members of CoSIDA. Saint Francis had three student-athletes receive the prestigious honor in 2007-08. The Red Flash men's basketball team has had five *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-Americans, including current assistant coach Rob Krimmel and former Dallas Maverick Mike Iuzzolino, who were both two-time honorees. Iuzzolino was the *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-American of the Year in 1991.
